Each year, Surrey Square Wheelers holds a "Happiness Dance" as the main fundraiser for our perennial designated charity, *The Centre for Child Development*.

This organization was originally formed in 1953 by a group of parents who wanted the new Lower Fraser Valley Cerebral Palsy Association to provide transportation so that their children could attend the G.F. Strong Centre in Vancouver. As the population in the Fraser Valley increased, the need for support and therapeutic services for a wide range of children's disabilities also increased. In 1973 a more local child development centre was built in Surrey.

Now, the Centre for Child Development has a number of outreach sites throughout the Fraser Valley from Delta to Abbotsford providing services to children and youth up to 19 years old who have complex, severe, and enduring developmental disabilities. The Centre's support, therapy and care assist more than 2400 children per year providing long-term and complex care.

In 2014, The Centre established *Sophie's Place* where physically, mentally and sexually abused children, up to age 18, are provided with specialized services in a caring and healing environment.
