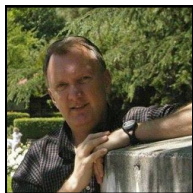

CUER'S BIO—Heather Reynolds



Heather began square dancing in Sept. of 1994 at the age of seven with the Wesburn Wranglers Square Dance Club of Burnaby, B.C. For 11 years, Heather competed in the annual Pacific Northwest Teen Square Dance Festival (PNTSDF) and won awards for Calling, Cueing, Square Dancing and Round Dancing.

Beginning in the winter of 2001 Heather cued and called square dance tips for many of the local clubs. Since September 2009 Heather has been the Cuer/Instructor for Swinging Singles Round Dance Class, along with her dad, Blair Wallace, as helper. Also with this club, she became their Beginner/Mainstream Caller in 2014. Since September 2010, Heather has been the full time Caller/Cuer for the Abbotsford 'Grand' Squares, where she teaches and calls square dances at the Basic through Plus levels.

Heather has been on the program for the Fraser Valley Square & Round Dance Association's (FVS&RDA) annual Gala twice, once as the Caller and once as the Cuer. Heather has called and cued dances in the Okanagan and Thompson Shuswap. She was Round Dance coordinator for six years for the Vancouver & District Caller/Teachers' Association (V&DCTA) and the Vice President for two years. Heather chaired the three most recent Roundarees held by the V&DCTA. Heather has also been a judge at the PNTSDF for many years. In 2016 she won the FVSRDA Scroll of Honour.
