Comments on the Financial Statements

We are gradually returning to Post COVID new normal operation. Most clubs have resumed dancing and the first phase of the registration process for 2023 has been completed.

The financial statements reflect the club and dancer registration fees that were collected and forwarded. Most of the fees collected by the FVSRDA are BC Square and Round Dance Federation (BCSRDF) fees and Canadian Square and Round Dance Society (CSRDS) fees that are forwarded to the BCSRDF.

Publication of print versions of the Valley Circle has resumed. In addition, charging for subscriptions and advertising has resumed.

The financial statements reflect the subscription and advertising income and the printing and postage expenses associated with producing and distributing the Valley Circle. Aside from these two areas there are some minor expenses for badges and the Scroll of Honour award.

Comments on 2023 Registration

Eighteen clubs have registered for 2023. The 2023 Registration Report lists the clubs that have registered and the number of dancers that have registered at each club. So far 360 dancers have registered for 2023. Normally, additional dancers are added in January and later months as some clubs start new dancer classes.

Fifty-four of the 360 dancers registered for 2023 were not registered previously in the FVSRDA.

The BCSRDF refunded \$1200 in 2022 dancer registration fees. Clubs that paid these fees received a credit for the fees that they paid in 2022 when they paid their 2023 fees.

"Social Media advertising Initiative" update -- Greg Dahlgren

Current activities

Facebook Group ads started again in Dec 2022 for New Dancer classes in Jan 2023. This time only two clubs participated. Chilliwack specifically declined as they were not taking any new people but they had good success in the fall from these ads with 35 new people registering "for more information".

Wendy Krueger's Club trained in December to do these ads themselves and so far seem to be handling it very well. I am happy to train any/all clubs to do their own posting. Training took 30 minutes in a Zoom meeting with Wendy and her new club 'Advertising Executive'. I will give each club all the current sites to advertise on with training on 'how to'. You only are required to have a Facebook account... or create a Facebook account for your club to use for this purpose. Posting each time you want to advertise take between 5-10 minutes it is extremely easy. I can post to all Facebook Groups that I have found in the area of Wendy's club in 2 minutes.

I posted for Town N Country once a week starting Dec 15th for our Jan 13th New Dancer classes and we received approximately 26 people expressing interest. We did also posted one ad in the Maple Ridge Times and the Tri-City News but from all accounts we only received 1 person from these ads.

My conclusion from the last 2 years on this project is that this form of advertising is extremely effective, easy to do AND FREE (if done with very little volunteer time). I would encourage all clubs to contact me to use this for their New Dancer Classes. If you cannot do it yourselves with my training, I will continue to do it for all clubs for the following years New Dancer Classes. I will need your 'New Dancer Coordinator' contact information. Additionally any Poster you want me to use. My email is GregDa@outlook.com. All clubs should contact me in June or July to prepare for New Dancer Classes in September 2023. I usually start ads for Town N Country in June posting every couple weeks. In August I am posting weekly (or more) so plan your own clubs advertising needs accordingly.

This concludes my update on current Facebook Group advertising activity.

I will take this opportunity to update the FVSRDA on the project.

The premise of this project was to see if this form of advertising was affective and if it proved so, use it to promote Square Dancing indefinitely on a year around basis. So far so good.

Cost of the project:

This project was approved with a 5,000.00 budget to the Promotions Committee from the FVSRDA in 2019. I was to hire and manage someone to scope out and run a Facebook Advertising project. Only a little under 400.00 was spent with the original student hire whom fleshed out the project and documentation so all clubs could take on the task for their own club.

An additional benefit of this form of advertising was to promote Square Dancing year-round to raise awareness for our activity hoping to make recruitment easier each New Dancer class start-up. When the student resigned from the project, the development was 80% complete. As such I decided to run the project myself until Covid was no longer an issue and all clubs were able to get dancing again. Now that most clubs are dancing again I have no plan to hire another person to run the project. The Promotions Committee will need to discuss how this project can be used to help Square Dancing activity in the lower mainland onward and if hiring another person to work the day-to-day tasks is prudent moving forward. This concludes the Project detail.

Betty has asked Wendy to mention them to the BCSRDF to see if they can get rid of the 8 remaining calendars.

3. **50 & 60 year pins** (Sandi Poje)

I have dancers asking me about 25 year dancer bars, 50 year pins and 60 year pins. Between Jean Galbraith and I, we have managed to track down the person who is responsible for making the 50 and 60 year pin (which we have 2 dancers who qualify for these pins). The person Jean and I contacted is Lisa Desjardine and she works for what was once called "Press Metal". Their main office has moved to somewhere in Quebec, and would take at least 6 months to create these pins. She quoted \$35.00 for each pin to be made, and a discount to \$27.00 if you order 5. She still has the mold to make these pins, but would like the order to be at least over \$100.00 to start. If we ordered 5 of each pin (50 and 60 year), that would be \$270.00, plus taxes, etc. She said it would probably take a few months to get the order filled. I spoke to Lisa around the 1st of December, and they were backlogged at that time. We did have these pins in stock, but somehow they were misplaced. This would give us a few on hand, if other dancers have reached that goal of dancing for 50 or 60 years.

I did telephone Lisa on Monday, January 16th and she is away until January 23rd so I will contact her later.

I would like approval to order 5-50 year pins and 5-60 year pins for a total of approximately \$270.00 plus taxes, etc.
