d) Promotion Committee - Frank McNeil

- Our radio ad campaign ran for 6 weeks from August 5th to September 15th on 104.3 The Breeze. We had several responses through danceforfun.ca web site to the ad.
- More clubs are using Facebook to advertise as a result of the Social Media Initiative, and they are seeing results in New Dancer attendance.
- Five sidewalk signs have been purchased and distributed to clubs that wanted them. The sign is on the cover of the September issue of the Valley Circle.
- Watch for the "First Friday Modern Square Dance Party" at Kennedy Hall. Visit danceforfun.ca to view the flyer.
- We are investigating the possibility of restarting Square Dance programs in Universities and Colleges in the Lower Mainland. The institutions we have contacted are not receptive to having a non-student group come in to do the program, so we are rethinking our approach to the idea.
- Promotion ideas from the past are being looked at and we may repeat some of these.
- Friday dances by Brent 1st Friday of each month, which promote square dancing are on the danceforfun.ca website
- 5 signs were distributed: White Rockers, Town 'n' Country (at their new location), Brent's Bunch, Wheeling 8's (at Guildford Rec Centre), Century House
- Wesburn Wranglers and Circle 8's would like a sign, as well, for the community centre.

 Lyle has ordered two more but would like to have more orders put together before ordering any more.

e) BC Federation - Dianne Wilson

- The 3 grants expired March 31, 2023
- It was moved the Class Advertising Grant of up to \$500 per member club be made available to all current member clubs of BCSRDF who are planning to attract new dancers and who submit an application for the Class Advertising Grant.

j) 50- & 60- year pins – Sandi Poje

- As I mentioned before in a previous FVS&RDA meeting, that this was not my job, but I have continued on, as I felt it was important (now that dancers are back dancing), that they should receive their 25-year dangles, or their 50 and 60 year pins.
- I also mentioned the cost, and since then, the cost is more than what was approved. So, I mentioned to Don that I have the invoice and I would speak on the Executive meeting. The invoice is for \$414.40, but when I started handing out the applications forms, I received more dancers who qualified for their pins. To date we have a total of 8 dancers for their 50-year pins, and 2 dancers for their 60-year pin. I did order more than was first approved for a total of 3 60-year pins and 12 50-year pins. I have handed the pins and the application forms to Alex for distribution. Hopefully I don't have to pay the balance out of my own pocket!!
- I have attached the invoice, the list of dancers who should receive their pins (see below), and a copy of the letter I sent to Don Allen, treasurer.
- Also, I have written to Sandy Badges about the 25-year bars, and she doesn't have a distributor any more. So a couple of dancers have requested their bar, but... the cost of these 25 year bars were \$4.00 each from Sandy's Badges, so I asked how much one of these bars would cost when I had the Scroll of Honour Badge engraved, and she said approximately \$15.00 with the graphics, but the price might depend on how many you were purchasing. I have their business card if someone would like to do the work on this project.

k) BC FESTIVAL 2025 - Ray Brendzy

The committee has had some challenges:

- Date--
 - Many festivals competing in July which conflicted with our first choice. As a result, we are moving dates July 30-Aug 2 which is the BC Day weekend
 - o Still waiting to hear back from the school as to confirmation of dates for the venue
- Venue-
 - o LSS has some changes because they're hosting summer school which ends on that weekend
 - We will have 3 rooms available that won't be affected by summer school
- Parking—
 - We need to check to make sure that there is ample parking for the new date
- Trail-In/Trail-Out dances
 - Venue still to be determined

NEW BUSINESS -

- 1. FVSRDA EXECUTIVE moved by Maureen Wilson/Seconded by Jean Galbraith to support the following motion:
 - Norm background
 - In 2018 received \$100,000 from Singles dancing fund to support dancers in the valley Committee members: Alex & Jean Galbraith, Sandi Poje, Norm Cox, Don Allen).
 - The intention was to \$10,000 each year that needed the money
 - 2018 Since then no money has been given out.
 - Proposal: To give \$1000 to each club for their startup
 - every club will receive it form not required
 - will be coming at the beginning of November when the 90 day term matures
 - Clubs must be registered for the 2023-24 dance season
 - Cheques will be made out to the club's name (can't write cheques to a personal name)
 - Ray suggested that clubs receive money PER NIGHT should this be considered?
 - Don there is still an application if club's wants to apply
 - New dancer grant is also available deSmit grant (FV one each for the new dancers squares and rounds!!) also one from BC FED (Diane can give info) both are annual grants

Moved/Seconded: Norm Cox/Sandi Poje-- that the FVSDRDA give the sum of \$1000 to each club registered with FVS&RDA in 2023 to assist their dance season startup and continuation. — CARRIED

2. Zoom meetings vs. face-to-face meetings –Should we consider some meetings to include face-to-face contact, as was done in the past?

Suggestions:

- Face-to-face at least one or two meetings
- Hybrid works well/those who can't make it, stay home
- Due to the return of COVID would have to check into restrictions on hall rentals and insurance
- Rotate the face-to-face meetings around the different districts
- Centennial lodge has a good rate but very few days available -- check with halls as to availability
- Do survey to see how many people would be attending the AGM in May, if we had it in person
 May
- Contact those who were absent for this meeting to find out if it was a technical issue which is challenging
- Did they receive the email and link, or do we have an incorrect email address for them?
- Perhaps the directors could contact the clubs not participating in the zoom meetings to find out why they aren't doing so

Motion Norm Cox/Michelle Thiessen – move that we continue zoom meetings during the 2023-24 dance season – CARRIED (Motion opposed by Eva Matheson & Sandi Poje)

2b) **Addition to the agenda:** Facebook ad Report: Greg Dahlgren

The Facebook Group ads for this September new dancer classes did very well this year.

Town 'n' Country

- week 1 -- 19 new dancers showed for our 1 free night
- week 2 -- 13 new dancers returned for our paid classes

Circle 8's

• week 1 had 5 new dancers, 4 from our FBG ads. 1 from the radio ad

Valley Promenaders

• week 1 had 5 new dancers, 4 from their FBG ads which they are doing on thier own

Chilliwack Rhythm Reelers

• 16 new dancers. I believe Michelle noted all came from Brent and My posting the ads for the club in the final 3 weeks before their restart.

Surrey Square Wheelers

• As best I can gather, SSW has about 16 new dancers this year. I also posted a couple FBG ads for their club as they had trouble getting a volunteer to staff the position. Maureen took that on as well so I thought it prudent to help out as she does so much for square dancing already.

Abbotsford Grand Squares

• As best I can gather it looks like they have 10 new dancers this year. I did all their FBG advertising for them and will continue until such time as they can staff that position.

One note worth mentioning:

- Town N Country and Chilliwack has 3-4 times the Facebook Groups to advertise on as the other clubs. As such those two clubs' success with ads on Facebook will be better than the other clubs. We can however extrapolate potential for the other clubs from their results. More on this as I gather their data from their new dancer classes.

It is my opinion that this form of advertising is hands down by far, the best way to recruit new dancers. More work needs to be done to find additional FBGroups to advertise on for the clubs that only have a few from my original efforts with this project. The goal was to prove (or disprove) that this form of advertising works. In my mind it clearly does so much better than anything else that we cannot ignore its potential. Based on that and the positive feedback from this meeting, I will pursue finding a permanent hire for pay to run the project. I have asked the FVSRDA minutes to reflect that we should try first with any square dancer that would like the position as they would have the most to gain from the work. (reviving square dancing to a healthy level of dancers for every club). I will continue to gather data on its effectiveness AND issues plus monitor emails for square dancers that may want the job. The Promotions Committee will work in step with me to further the project.
