However, Greg Dahlgren reported on the Promotion Committee's *Facebook Marketing Initiative* as of May 2021.

Current cost = \$316.68 (of the \$10,000.00 budget set from the FVSRDA grant)

- NO FURTHER bills expected.
 - 1st hire quit Oct 2020 and I do not plan to rehire
- Project will be completed by myself (Greg D.)
 - I think we can decide on the merits of this test as to whether this project needs to be continued

Stats

July/Oct 2020 – 80 Facebook Groups were identified as possible targets to promote

Apr 17/21 – Membership requests sent to all 80 groups

From Apr 17/21 to May 30/21 - only 30 groups have accepted my request to join their Group

- This will definitely be a challenge to clubs using this method for Marketing.
 - I think identifying ourselves as 'Non-profit' is essential as some Groups assumed I was a business

To May 30/21

- 30 posters marketing square dance have been posted, 2 have been rejected (they assumes I was a business and this is not allowed for commercial use)
- To date I have approx. 12 responses asking to be put on the mailing list for beginner square dancing and/or more information requested
 - o I simply refer information requests to the FVSRDA website
 - o A mailing list is being documented for future use by clubs with beginner classes

[Greg] will continue to run this project within the Promotions Committee through the September 2021 square dancing restart at least. At that time, we should review how effective it has been and how cost affective it could be to square dancing. Currently the cost has been extremely small.

e) Driscoll Award – Ron Robertson

Because square dancing scheduling is, at this time, unpredictable and we are not sure if there will even be teen clubs in the future, the Driscoll Committee has decided to meet after the AGM meeting when things settle down and we have some idea of what is happening. Until then, we can only hope that we will still have teen clubs.

f) BC Federation – Betty Langtry

- Blair Wallace was awarded the Sillery Award. Congratulations, Blair!
- Executive will remain in place
- Treasury report basically remains the same
- President Jean Wood has resigned, citing health reasons
- Dennis Sutton, 1st vice president, will be assuming the position of president
- g) Canadian Society David McVige -- no report

h) Gala Committee – Dave Hammer (absent)

Since no venue is available for dancing and no time has been given when a venue will be available, Gala 2021, which was to be held on May 15th, 2021, has been cancelled. *Toni Oxendine* was the anticipated caller. As we look forward to Gala 2022, depending on the COVID- 19 situation in both Canada and the United States, it is anticipated to have callers *Steve Edlund* and U.S. caller, *Kevin Thomaier*. No specific date has been suggested, with so many variables to be considered. When more details become available, the square and round dancing community will be notified.

OLD BUSINESS-

1. **COVID 19 Back To Dancing Committee Report – Blair Wallace** (COVID-19 FVS&RDA AGM Report is sent as an attachment to the minutes)

In Blair's opinion, the following timeline is plausible:

Stage 1 - Starting Today

- No dancing

Stage 2 - June 15

- ALL dancing Indoor possible with COVID Safety Plan / reduced capacity

Stage 3 - July 1

- All dancing in larger groups with COVID Safety Plan

Stage 4 - September 7

- Back to "normal", masks personal choice.
- Likely will still require a COVID Safety Plan
 - The dates indicated are not before dates and depend on vaccination rates, low case counts, low hospitalizations -
 - The criteria for moving to Step 2 is at least 65% of the 18+ population vaccinated with dose 1, along with declining case counts and COVID-19 hospitalizations.
 - The criteria for moving to Step 3 is at least 70% of the 18+ population vaccinated with dose 1, along with low case counts and declining COVID-19 hospitalizations.
 - The criteria for moving to Step 4 is more than 70% of the 18+ population vaccinated with dose 1, along with low case counts and low COVID-19 hospitalizations.
 - The "low case counts and low COVID-19 hospitalizations" not defined.

Blair added that, in light of the possible September start up of a regular dance season, clubs are asked to submit any ads to the Valley Circle no later than **August 20**th in order to guarantee that they appear in the September issue, which will be mailed out to everyone with an existing subscription.

2. FVS&RDA Elections - David McVige

We were unable to find anyone to fill the positions of **President** or **Vice President** at this time, so those two positions remain vacant. **Don Allan** and **Maureen Wilson** have agreed to continue in their present position as Treasurer and Secretary respectively. The executive will appoint a fourth director, in future.

NEW BUSINESS -

1. Donation to the Heart and Stroke Foundation in memory of Guy Tryssenaar, in lieu of flowers

The following motion was moved, seconded and carried at our FVSRDA Executive meeting, held on Saturday, May 22, 2021.
