1. Social Media Initiative project presented by Greg Dahlgren

Project Activity -- Posting ads from June 2022 -- Running weekly starting mid-July, if allowed.

- I get a strong reaction immediately with many questions even during my posting activity. It is clear that we are hitting our target market.
- The best areas with the highest number of groups I post to are: Maple Ridge/Pitt Meadows, Chilliwack, and Abbotsford.

OLD BUSINESS-

- 1. **COVID 19 Committee Report** Blair
 - Work is done
 - Blair thanked those who were members of the committee

Moved/Seconded: Blair Wallace/Norm Cox-- Motion to disband the COVID committee -- CARRIED

Question: Does that mean that there is an end to proof of vaccination and mask mandate for clubs? Blair: This is left up to clubs and individual dancers

- 2. **Letter from the V&DCTA** -- Maureen reported that she presented the secretary of the VDCTA, Wendy Krueger with a copy of the letter, in a response to their request, indicating that the FVSRDA was reducing their number of BCSRDF dancer directors-at-large from two to one, thus making room for the VDCTA to appoint a caller for that position, if they so choose to do so.
- 3. Nominations for FV executive/committee vacancies (Norm)

Norm: Do we have a nominating committee?

Answer: No

- Norm phoned two people
- Jean contacted some people but is waiting to hear back.
- By-laws state that, in order to run for the position of president, the candidate would have to have been a FVSRDA executive or committee member for a minimum of one year prior to seeking the position.
- Possible solution: There is no such restriction for the position of Vice President. If a president is unable or unwilling to carry out their assigned duties then the vice president can carry out the duties in their stead.
